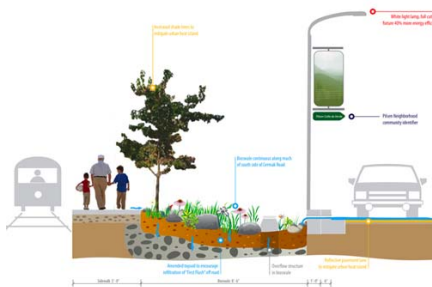
### For a valuable workshop for stormwater professionals in Northeast Ohio
